The Concord-Carlisle High School Parents Association would like to reiterate its sincerest apology for the recent social media post regarding parking at CCHS. We regret that the post caused harm and acknowledge the pain it created.

We respectfully request that the Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion Commission's letter to Alexa Anderson, on which we were not cc'd, be removed from the Town website. The letter does not reflect the initial and immediate public apology the CCHS PA posted on Instagram and Facebook on September 19th; it also raises concerns about the practice and precedent of publishing letters that include the names of private citizens on an official municipal site.
